Clerk gave an update on the past due utilities report.

Street Repairs: Blacktop Paving will begin street repairs this week.

Water System: Hansen reported that he and ILRW are continuing the water testing and determining the best route for correction of chlorine levels.

Community Center – Nothing new to report

Alliant Energy Rebuild – Hansen will visit with Alliant regarding the final items needing done.

Insurance Claim – Roof Replacements – The remaining roofs will be replaced the week of Aug 5.

Drainage System – Work continues.

Insurance Recommendations – Work continues on all recommendations.

Fire Hydrant – Hansen reported he is still waiting for a quote.

Motion was made by Fritz to waive the third reading of Ordinance Title III, Chapter 1, Article 3- Minors, Section 3.6, 5; Ordinance Title IV, Chapter 1, Article 5- Parking Regulations, Section 5.11; and Ordinance Appendix A, Section 5, effective January 1, 2019. Meyer seconded the motion. Roll Call vote: Meyer-Aye, Fritz-Aye, Hansen-Aye, Loontjer – Aye, Spooner - Aye. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Fritz to approve the second reading and adoption of Ordinance Title III, Chapter 1, Article 3- Minors, Section 3.6, 5. Meyer seconded the motion. All present voted aye. Motion carried. – *Title III, Chapter 1, Article 3- Minors, Section 3.6, 5 – Penalties, a: Responsible Adult’s Violation – Simple Misdemeanor. Any responsible adult as defined in this Chapter who knowingly allows a minor to violate any of the provisions of this Section shall be guilty of a simple misdemeanor, and upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed Two Hundred dollars (\$200.00).*

Motion was made by Fritz to approve the second reading and adoption of Ordinance Title IV, Chapter 1, Article 5. Loontjer seconded the motion. All present voted aye. Motion carried. *Title IV, Chapter 1, Article 5- Parking Regulations, Section 5.11 – Violation – Violation of a provision of this Article of the Webb City Code, unless otherwise provided, shall constitute a simple misdemeanor punishable as provided pursuant to the Code of Iowa Appendix A, Section 5.*

Motion was made by Meyer to approve the second reading and adoption of Ordinance Appendix A, Section 5. Fritz seconded the motion. All present voted aye. Motion carried. *Appendix A, Section 5. Parking Violations. A. PARKING VIOLATIONS Admitted violations of any parking restrictions imposed by this Title IV, Chapter 1 of Webb’s Municipal Code, upon a simple notice of a fine as set \$25.00, payable at the office of the City Clerk. If such fine is not paid within seventy-two (72) hours, then the following may occur: 1-4-1: PENALTY: Conviction of a violation of any provision of this Code may result in the sentence of a fine; not less than sixty five dollars (\$65.00) and not to exceed six hundred twenty five dollars (\$625.00). Criminal penalty surcharges imposed under State law shall be added to a City fine and are not a part of any fine imposed by the City. These penalties shall apply to every section of this Code, as if the section were set out in every other section of this Code. 1-4-2:*

*SEPARATE OFFENSE: If a violation of this Code is committed on more than one calendar day, a separate offense shall be deemed to have occurred on each such calendar day. 1-4-3: SINGLE OFFENSE: In cases where action or inaction is made punishable by more than one provision of this Code, the City may select the provision or provisions of this Code under which to proceed. In such a circumstance, a single offense shall result in no more than one conviction and penalty, subject to the provisions of section 1-4-2 of this chapter. 1-4-4: LIABILITY OF OFFICERS: No provision of this Code designating the duties of any officer or employee of the City shall be construed to make such officer or employee liable for any fine or penalty for a failure to perform such duty, unless the intention of the Council to impose such a penalty is specifically and clearly expressed in this Code. 1-4-5: LICENSE REVOCATION; INFRACTION CHARGES; CIVIL REMEDIES: A violation of this Code, in addition to the penalties provided in this chapter, may subject the violator to loss of license or permit, a Municipal infraction charge, or other civil remedies provided in other section of this Code. Conviction and imposition of sentence under this chapter shall not bar any such other civil remedies.*

A building permit for Shane Bailey was presented. Council tabled the permit until the lot is surveyed and lot lines are determined and set backs are established.

Hansen motioned, seconded by Meyer to approve the building permit for Melissa Loontjer. All present voted aye, with Loontjer abstaining. Motion carried.

Other items of discussion included the condition of the parks and that garbage placed in garbage cans must be in bags in order to be picked up.

Motion to adjourn was made by Meyer and seconded by Loontjer.
