Clerk gave an update on the past due utilities report.

Community Center – All projects are done.

Resignation – Mayor Hildebrand has purchased a home and will be moving after June 30. A resignation was presented to the council. The council rejected the resignation, and asked Hildebrand to finish his term, as he will still be owning properties in town and will be able to attend the meetings. Mayor Pro Tem Anderson will be available for daily duties, as needed. Discussion on the need for future councilmen ensued.

Mowing Bids Update – Ball Park mowing will be done by All Out Landscaping for this season at the rate of \$40 per hour. Park bid remains as voted on last month.

Hansen moved, seconded by Fritz to approve the quote from All Out Landscaping for the south side of the community center. All present voted aye.

Other items of discussion – Selling the ball field property will be placed on the agenda next month. Mayor Hildebrand has offered to sell the speed radar sign to the city. It will placed on the agenda next month.

Motion to adjourn was made by Anderson and seconded by Meyer.
